

Monitoring/supervision of DMHP, improving the quality, analysing the district data, periodic review of the progress and action plans as and when required. To work in coordination with the Programme officer Mental Health in all technical issues.• Community awareness activities of DMHP and other Mental Health Programmes at district as well as at community (school teachers, elected leaders etc.)• To conduct <u>Manochaitanya clinics</u> at Taluk Hospitals on Tuesdays.• Consolidate the PHC/CHC/GH/Monthly reports, SOE etc & to be sent to DHS before 5th of every month (with Dlo's approval)• Conduct "on the job training" at PHC/CHC/TH/ Govt.Medical college, when difficult cases are seen at PHC/CHC/TH.• Analyse the progress and plan suitable strategies for all DMHP Activities.
